Contents:

Amended Draft of an Act for naturalising of Bernard Cosserat, als Mourté, and Alexander Ringli and others. Identical with Act, except that the names contained in the separate schedules on the Roll were added by the Commons (see Annex f) below.)

Annexed:

- a) 17 Jan -- Lords' Amendments in Committee this day. They consist in the addition of Sperling, Van Omme, Weymans, Soumans and Gronen to the Bill. Com. Book.
- b) 17 Jan -- Certificate that Bernard Cosserat, of London, Gent, had taken the Sacrament at the Church of St. Peter Lee Poore, London, on 6 Jan. Signed by Richard Leach, the Minister, and J. Oldbury, the Churchwarden, and attested by Alexander Ringli, of London, Gent., and Herman Olmius, of London, Merchant. Dated 6 Jan.
- c) 17 Jan -- Similar Certificate for Alexander Ringli, of London, Gent., attested by Cosserat and Olmius.
- d) 17 Jan -- Certificate that John Van Omme, of London, Merchant, had taken the Sacrament at the Established Protestant French Church on 6 Jan. Signed by Charles Piozet, the Minister, and attested by Anthony Gronen and Tho: Chaloner. Dated 14 Jan.
- e) 17 Jan -- Certificate that Mr. Henry Sperling from Dantzic, is a true Protestant, and took the Sacrament in the High German Lutheran late Parish Church, Trinity the Less, on 8 Jan. Signed by John Esdras Edzard, the Minister, and Theodore Jacobsen and David Becceler, the Trustees. Attested by Peter Meyer. Dated 10 Jan.
- f) 11 Feb -- Certificates that the persons added to the Bill by the Commons had taken the Sacrament, the first five in the true Protestant High German Lutheran late Parish Church, Trinity the Less, London, signed by John Esdras Edzard, the Minister, and Theodore Jacobsen and David Becceler, the Trustees of the said church; and the sixth in the Dutch Church in London, signed by Samuel Biscop, the Minister.
- f1) Herman Frederick Dorryen, on Christmas Day. Dated 1 Jan Attested Henry Ulcken, Peter Willoke.
- f2) Georg Stein, on Christmas Day. Dated and attested as preceding.
- f3) Henry Erick, on 6 Jan Dated 21 Jan. Attested David Teuffenwieser, Peter Willoke.
- f4) John Reinold Brand, on 3 Feb Dated 6 Feb. Attested J. Joyce, Peter Willoke.
- f5) John Warneck, on 3 Feb Dated 6 Feb. Attested Peter Meyer, Peter Willoke.
- f6) Jacob Henckel, on 30 Dec Dated 1 Jan. Attested Reinier Lampe, Lawrence Vandavelde.
